DEATH (MULTIPLE)

7/27/08 - Plffs, decedents, Brenda Houston, female age 47, pilot; and her daughter, Elizabeth Crews, female age 10. The decedents were on a Cessna aircraft when it lost power and crashed, killing all of its occupants. Plffs' Estates contended the engine power loss was due to a defectively designed carburetor.

Injuries: Death.

Settlement: Demand: \$2,700,000. Plff asked the jury for

\$20,000,000, plus punitive damages. Offer: none.

The Def. asked the jury for a defense verdict.

Result: PLAINTIFF VERDICT for \$17,283,000. (The verdict included

\$6,000,000 in punitive damages. No new trial presently

pending.)
